CONGRATULATIONS ON THE BISHOP APPEAL!!!!
We made it! Thanks to all of you who donated to our Bishop's Appeal, we made our goal of \$16,775.00 and surpassed it by \$25! This means that 30% of the \$16,800 that we donated will be given back as a rebate as a reward for reaching our goal!! What an incredible feat. Thank you for all your help and support in this regard. YAAAYYY!!!

A NEW ROOF FOR OUR CHURCH. Our roof has been leaking for the last ten years. Further repairs are not be economical; the roof needs to be replaced. We have chosen an expensive option that promises to provide 50-100+ years of protection for our sacred place and its contents. These roofs are better insulated than our current tile roof, so will provide savings on our electricity costs. It is also lighter weight which will be a blessing for our roof joists, brick, and walls which support the roof.

We have more than half the money raised from restricted donations for the roof (\$10,000 from the Ihnats) and building/remodel (\$10,000 from Marge Bobick and additional building fund money collected monthly from parishioners) purposes. For the remaining funds, we plan to use our parish savings account. However, if any of you would like to designate a particular donation to help pay for the new roof, that would be greatly appreciated! The

color which most parishioners voted for was English Suede so that is the color we have ordered. It will be installed in August, after the monsoon season.

WAYS TO HELP OUR CHURCH WITH TALENT. Church is more than a building. It is primarily the people of God, the Mystical Body of Christ. For Christ's Church to be fully alive and vibrant, it takes our participation in prayer and liturgical services, and also requires many helpers to maintain and enhance our physical presence. Our Eparchial Pastoral Handbook says that a parishioner "is willing to support the growth of the Church by sharing his/her Time, Talent and Treasure (financial support)." (P.H. #437-g) Please look at the the parish ministries in the bulletin insert or as a handout in the narthex and ask the Lord if He is calling you to serve in any of them. We will have a sign up list in mid-July for this.

ATTENTION MEN AND BOYS: Have you considered helping to glorify God through serving on the altar? We are holding a training session on August 5 for men and boys. For some, it may be a simple refresher course. For others, it may be an introduction to serving at the altar for the first time. Coming to this session does not mean you must become an altar server, but it will help boost confidence in knowing how to serve.
