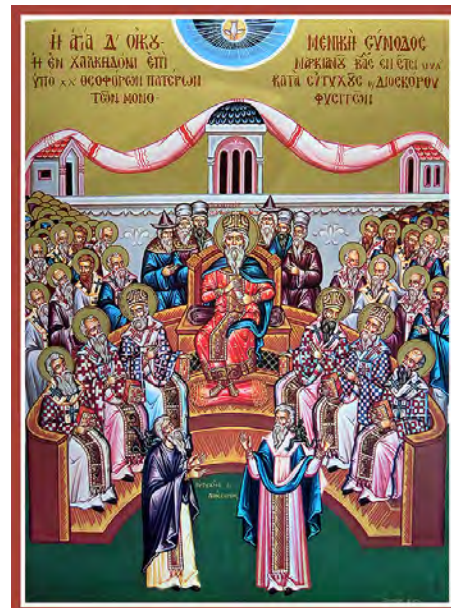

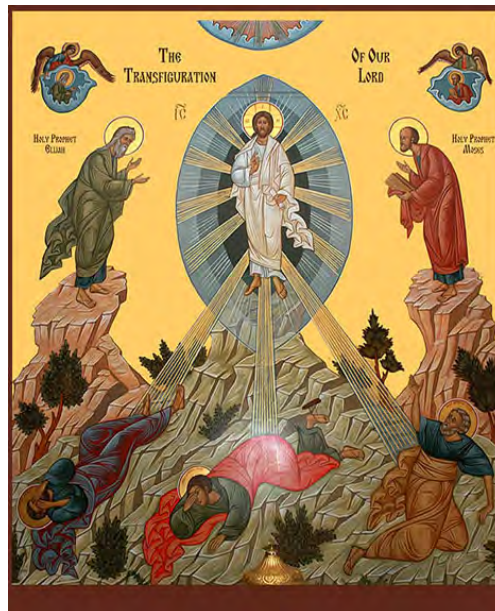
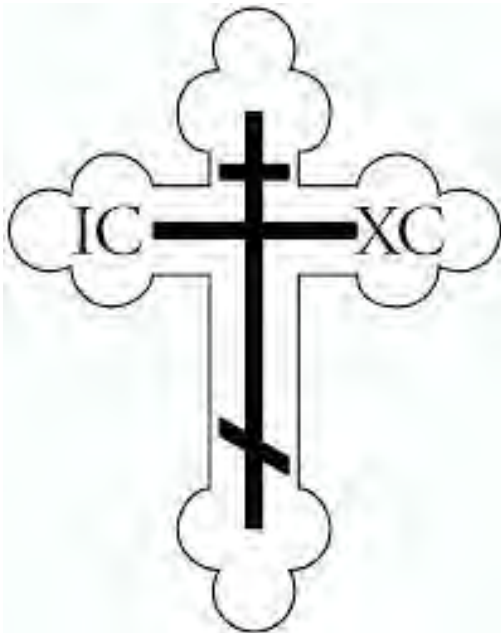

Dormition Fast

The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified the period of August 1-14 every year as a penitential season. By tradition it is a period of strict abstinence with the usual mitigations. Common practice in recent years has been to adopt at the very minimum some increased level of abstinence beyond that of non-penitential seasons. The observance of this fast is voluntary.
