ANNOUNCEMENTS

BISHOP'S APPEAL: This year, our bishop is asking each household to donate \$275.00 to the eparchy to help it with its ministry and programs it sponsors. I'd like to see 100% participation even if it means a few people who donate less than \$275 give around \$50 instead of nothing. Others can perhaps donate \$500 or more. If our parish reaches its goal of \$16,775.00, it will obtain a 30% rebate of those funds from the eparchy as a reward for reaching that goal. Let's include the Bishop's Appeal in our extra charitable giving during the Great Fast. As of March 3, we have collected \$1,510.00 toward our \$16,775.00 goal. If you did not receive a mailing from Bishop John regarding the Bishop's Appeal and would like to make a donation to it, please let Fr. Michael know. Thank you!

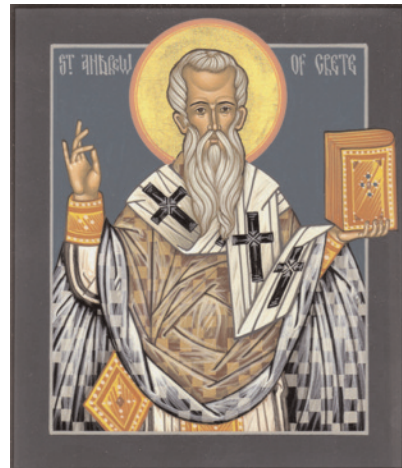
