MATINS CONTINUES: As mentioned last month, we are offering Matins services on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday of every week from 8:00-9:00 am. Occasionally there is an exception to the 8am time, but it will be listed in the bulletin. Cancellations (VERY RARE) will be announced in church and/or communicated via email. Feel free to come and experience a public celebration of the morning prayers of our Byzantine Church!

HOUSE BLESSINGS: Getting your home blessed between Theophany and the Great Fast (Lent) by a priest is an important Byzantine Catholic tradition. Many choose to have their home blessed every year although many are comfortable with a blessing every other year or every few years. Our homes need to be blessed on a frequent basis with holy water to drive away the demons and welcome the protection of the holy angels. Fr. Michael is available from January 12 to February 25 on many Thursday evenings after 3pm and Saturday mornings. RSVP no later than January 15 to saint.thomas.pastor@gmail.com or hand me a hand-written note (or call the office) with your address, phone number, and at least three dates and times that could work for you so we can set this up. Also let me know if this is the first time you are getting your house blessed as there are a few extra prayers for such an occasion. House blessings usually take about 20-30 minutes but can take longer if you invite the pastor to a snack or meal. Sometimes, parishioners in a region like to group together and have a potluck at the last house blessed that day. My preference is to group people together, especially if someone wants to share a meal at the last house. Be proactive and let me know your schedule today! (RSVP deadline: January 15)
