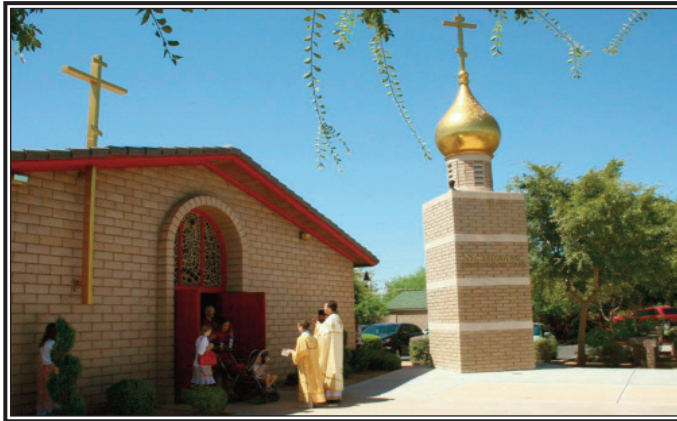

ANNOUNCEMENTS

HOUSE BLESSINGS CONTINUE: Fr. Michael is making progress blessing homes. They seem to be averaging about 30 minutes for homes that have not been blessed previously (which includes anointing oil prayers) not including visiting time. (Previously blessed homes take about 15-20 minutes). If preparing a potluck or snack, please DO NOT COOK with mushrooms and uncooked tomatoes as Fr. Michael is allergic to them. Fr. Michel finds it a delight to get to know parishioners better through seeing and blessing their homes.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT: On Tuesday, February 7 at 7:00pm, Jennifer Mikitish will give a very important presentation to our adults on creating a safe environment for children in our homes, schools, and churches. This is not about playground and tree-climbing safety. This presentation will cover how to be vigilant in order that abuse may be prevented and what to do if you suspect its occurrence. This is not something that just parents of current minors should attend. It is something for all adults of our parish to attend if possible.

PARISH PICNIC: On Meatfare Sunday, we often have our annual picnic at Freestone Park. This is a great time to spend extra time with each other in community! Basketball courts are nearby. Sign-up sheets are in the hall for bringing a food item. Our reservation is from 11:30am to 3:00pm on February 19 at Ramada B which is also called the Courtside Ramada. See you there!

THINKING AHEAD TO THE GREAT FAST: Notice that the Sundays of Meatfare and Cheesefare are coming up. This is a sign we are preparing for the Great Fast (Great Lent). This is the most important time for kenosis (self-emptying) so we can share in the joy of the risen

Lord in Pascha (Easter). The minimum abstinence that the Metropolia requires of all parishioners is that we do not eat meat or dairy on the first day of the Great Fast (which is February 27) nor on Good Friday (April 14). In addition, we are required to abstain from meat on all Wednesdays and Fridays. That is the minimum required! The traditional fast of our Tradition is to abstain from eating meat AND dairy throughout all of Lent with a mitigation of wine and oil on Sundays and feast days. It is usually best to choose a fasting regimen in a particular year that will not kill us from starvation nor be super easy. It should be uncomfortable. We are encouraged to share more fully in the sufferings of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ out of love for Him. We not only pick ways of fasting but also seek to increase our prayer life. More prayer services take place at church such as Presanctified Liturgies which are held on Wednesdays and Fridays. Let us do the harder work of cooperating with the Lord during this time so a beautiful spiritual blossoming might take place at the time of Pascha!

ALL SOULS SATURDAYS: Please check your calendar and plan on attending AT LEAST one All Souls Saturday to pray for the faithful departed. Your loved ones will be glad you made the effort. Please be sure to also update our diptychs, the lists of deceased people you want the priest and deacon to pray for at these Divine Liturgies followed by a Panahida. The last day to make changes to this list is February 12.

- **February 26:** Forgiveness Sunday. Forgiveness among parishioners exchanged at end of Liturgy.
- **February 27:** Beginning of the Great Fast
- **Presanctified Liturgies** at 7pm: Feb. 27, March 1, 3 (soup fellowship afterward), March 8, 10 (soup fellowship afterward). Pattern continues on all Wednesdays and Fridays of the Great Fast.
- **March 11:** Second All Souls Saturday at 9:00 am.
- **March 18:** Third All Souls Saturday at 9:00 am.
- **March 25:** Solemn Feast of the Annunciation at 9:00 am.
- **March 30:** Matins of the Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete at 7:00pm (evening instead of morning so more parishioners can come).
- **April 9-15:** Holy Week. Come often!
